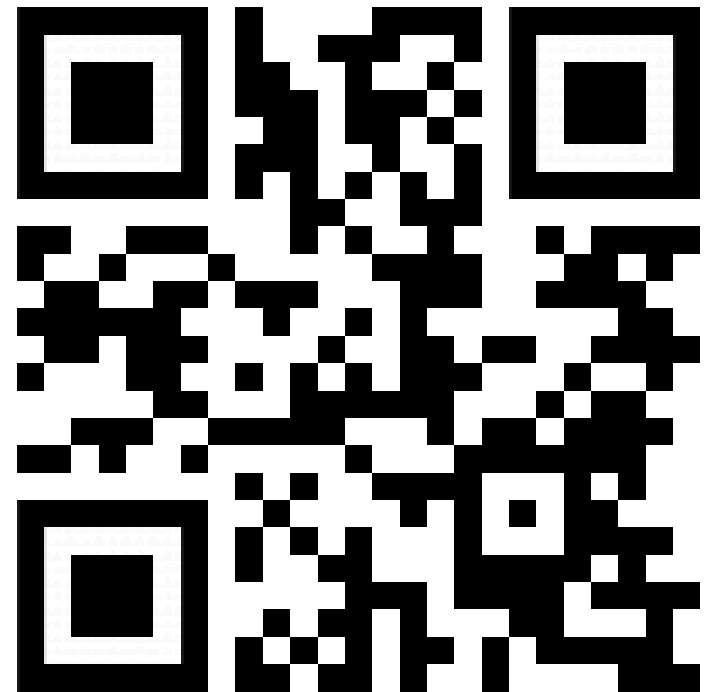

 - Next elections in December 2018

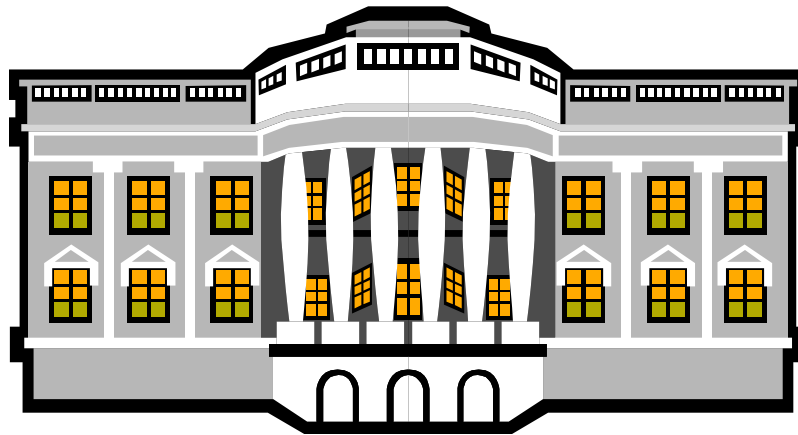


What does the FSR ISE do?

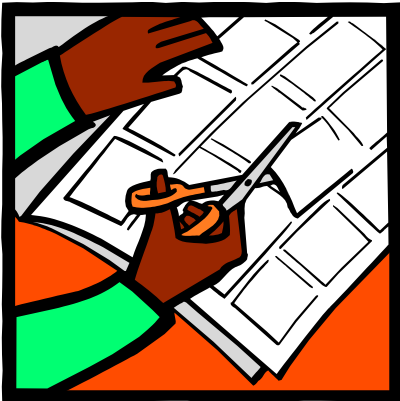

Kulturticket

- **How much is the culture ticket?**

Per visit you pay only **1 Euro!**

- **Which events can I attend with it?**

Almost all events of the Theater and Philharmonic Essen (opera, ballet, drama, concert). Premieres and similar events are excluded.

- **Where and how do I get the ticket?**

You have to submit an application form and a current study certificate (the date of birth, matriculation number) at the Theater Essen once. This is by e-mail to kulturticket@tup-online.de, by mail or at the box office. You will then receive the Kulturticket by post, which you have to bring with you on every visit.

- **When can I buy a ticket for a performance?**

From 7 days before a performance you can reserve a card. The reservation is then valid until one day before the performance, so you have to buy the ticket by then. At the box office, you can spontaneously ask for tickets, but there is no guarantee. Seat reservations and the online purchase of a ticket is not possible.

LuDi der Physik

Hinter dem Begriff „LUDI“ verbergen sich sogenannte „Lern- und Diskussionszentren“, die jüngst in einigen Fakultäten – insbesondere im technisch-naturwissenschaftlich Bereich – eingerichtet werden bzw. schon eingerichtet worden sind. Es handelt sich dabei um einen modern ausgestatteten Seminarraum mit Gruppentischen und Whiteboard, der den Studierenden insgesamt 16 Stunden pro Woche zu festen Zeiten zur Verfügung steht. Für eine „Rund-um-Betreuung“ der Studierenden sorgen zusätzlich Tutoren. So haben die Studierenden zum Beispiel die Möglichkeit, Ihre wöchentlich zu bearbeitenden Hausaufgaben unter Hilfestellung der Tutoren – meist fortgeschrittene Studierende – zu erledigen. Aus diesem Grund sind die Öffnungszeiten des LUDI an die Kernvorlesungszeiten der Studienanfänger weitestgehend angepasst. Eine ideale Gelegenheit Freistunden optimal zu nutzen: Arbeiten und Lernen in der Gemeinschaft.

LuDi of physics

The term "LUDI" covers so-called "learning and discussion centers", which have recently been set up or have already been set up in some faculties - especially in the technical-scientific field. It is a state-of-the-art seminar room with group tables and whiteboard that is available to students for a total of 16 hours a week at fixed times. Tutors also provide "all-round care" for the students. For example, students have the opportunity to complete their weekly homework assignments with the help of tutors - mostly advanced students. For this reason, the opening hours of the LUDI are largely adapted to the core lecture times of the undergraduate students.
